COLLEGE PROCESS INFO

College Applications

- Students should submit their college applications by the early action deadline.
- Make sure to add your colleges to MAIA Learning.
- Once you submit a college app be sure to then request the transcript in MAIA Learning.
- If you are applying to any college via the Common App, they require a counselor req. Please request these now.

Recommendation Requests

- Requests should be made <u>AT</u> <u>LEAST</u> 3 weeks in advance
- If you are applying to any college via Common App you will need a "counselor recommendation" so ask for these now.
- Ask your teachers before making an official request on MAIA Learning
 - a. Complete the Brag Sheet (All students must complete this task - which can be found in Schoology.)
 - b. Make your official request on MAIA Learning
 - c. <u>See this video</u> on how to add recommenders in MAIA.

FINANCIAL AID

- Starting Oct 1, you can begin submitting your FAFSA/CASFA/CSS Profile
- Make sure to complete the 2022-2023 application
- Check out <u>these resources</u> in Schoology to help support you in gathering the necessary documents to complete the FAFSA/CASFA starting on Oct 1

Transcript Requests

- You must submit a transcript request form for **<u>EACH</u>** college you apply to via MAIA Learning.
- See <u>this video</u> for a MAIA tutorial on how to request transcripts.
- To ensure all of your materials are sent in by the deadline be sure to do this in advance and check in with Ms. Sierra to make sure all your docs (Counselor recommendation, teacher recommendation, common app eval forms) are uploaded.

TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL SENIOR YEAR

- 1. Check your Future Center Schoology course at least twice a week.
 - a. You will find many resources to help you with the college application process and financial aid. Updates are made each week about upcoming events, scholarships, and other great opportunities.
- 2. Meet with one of your college advisors at least once a semester. College advisors include Ms. Lopez, the GEAR UP advisors, and Ms. Sierra.
 - a. You can meet with us as much or as little as you prefer. You can drop in the Future Center or schedule an appointment.
- 3. Apply to all of your colleges by the "Early Action" Deadline.
 - a. If you apply by the Early Action deadline you are guaranteed to know if you are admitted no later than January.
- 4. Start applying for scholarships now! <u>Check out this scholarship link</u> where Ms. Sierra will add any and all scholarships sent to her. New scholarships are added every Monday.
