## DPS 2020-2021 Live Online SAT Prep Course

## Program Outline, Online Registration, and Student Agreement

**Hey Juniors!** Denver Public Schools (DPS) is providing 11th grade DPS students with a free Live Online SAT Prep Course to help prepare them for the upcoming Colorado School Day Administration of the SAT in April. This is an amazing opportunity for you to take advantage of!

## 1. Live Online SAT Prep Course

The Live Online SAT Prep Course includes:

- 18 hours of live instruction delivered in an interactive online classroom (9 sessions, each 2 hours long)
- 8 practice tests, including 4 Official College Board exams
- Thousands of practice questions
- Supplemental video instruction, including quizzes with video explanations
- SAT prep books

Two different class sessions will be offered: one on Tuesdays and one on Saturdays. **Students must pick** one class and attend all the sessions for that class.

\*The required practice test helps students to understand their strengths and weaknesses on the SAT.

In partnership with DPS, Kaplan Test Prep operates the entire test preparation program and leads all instruction and practice exams. Kaplan Inc. has over 80 years of experience in test preparation.

The instructional sessions offer a variety of strategies on how to analyze problems, interpret "SAT language", develop a personal pace for taking the exam, and other important topics. These sessions are led by trained Kaplan Test Prep instructors.

#### 2. Eligibility Requirements and Student Selection Process

Every 11th grader currently enrolled in DPS is eligible to participate in the Live Online SAT Prep Course. There are a limited number of spots in the program. In the event there is more student interest than space permits, priority will be given to students on a first-come first-served basis determined by when they submitted their registration form. If the class chosen by the student is full but there is room in the other class, he/she will automatically be registered for the other class.

Students will be notified on Friday, January 8th letting them know if they secured a spot in the program or not. If accepted, other important enrollment details will be included. All email correspondence will be sent via the student's DPS/school email account.

## 3. Assignments, Homework, Practice Tests and SAT Prep Books

All students will be provided with homework assignments and are required to take simulated SAT Practice tests. All assignments, homework and tasks are due as the instructor indicates to students. It is important that all tasks and assignments be completed regularly in a timely fashion and turned in promptly if/when required. All students that are accepted into the program will receive SAT prep books directly from Kaplan. They will be mailed to your home address. These books are for you to use both during the live sessions and on your own throughout the week between sessions.

#### 4. Commitment

The DPS Live Online SAT Prep Course is geared towards working with students and providing the tools necessary to be prepared for the Colorado School Day Administration of the SAT. You, the student, are responsible for your preparedness. This preparation course will help you get there but only if you attend all live sessions and put in the time and effort outside of the sessions.

#### 5. The official exam date for the Colorado SAT is Tuesday, April 13, 2021

Following the Live Online SAT Prep Course, all DPS 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will participate in the official Colorado School Day Administration of the SAT on Tuesday, April 13, 2021. Please note: students will be tested at their home school.
